WHAT IS YH₂O?

YH₂O is a six-month program which prepares young adults to be hired in the water and solid waste industries in a variety of positions including:

- Utility Installer Apprentice
- Operations Technician Apprentice
- General Laborer
- Meter Reader/ Utility Specialist
- Landscaper
- Street Sweeper
- Customer Care Analyst
- Marine Operations



WHY SHOULD I APPLY?

Baltimore City's water industry offers immediate full-time entry-level job opportunities with the potential for career growth and advancement.

- Job Readiness and Hands-on Training (i.e. resume writing, professional etiquette)
- Job Shadowing

- An Individual Career Coach

Baltimore City, Baltimore County, Anne Arundel County and Howard County residents, 18 – 24-year old who have a high school diploma or GED, are unemployed or underemployed, and are not currently enrolled in a job training program or post-secondary education.
